

Join Us and Volunteer



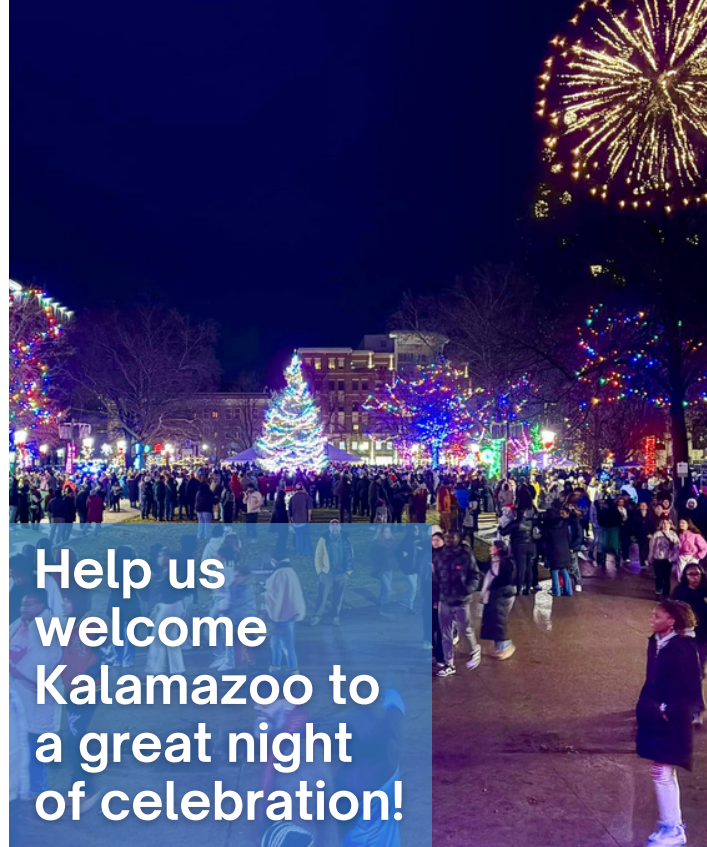

New Year's Fest

New Year's Fest is a performing arts festival that centers around Bronson Park with five different venues that host performances. The 22 different performing artists include magicians, comedians, classical performances, bands, and even silent films.

Buttons are used as an admission fee and it is \$10 in advance and \$15 on December 31. The activities in Bronson Park are free and including a Ball Drop and fireworks.

Volunteers are needed to help welcome attendees, check buttons, direct traffic in buildings, and just be great ambassadors to the people who come to celebrate the performing arts. And, while you volunteer, you get to see the shows.

Button Checker

Button checkers are needed to welcome the guests to New Year's Fest and check admission buttons. It's like a flash pass check. And, when everyone is inside the venue, you can watch the show while you watch the doors.

Shift times: 5:45-7:45 p.m.
7:30-9:30 p.m.
9:15-11:15 p.m.

Arts & Crafts Supervisor

If you love crafting and a little chaos, this job is for you. From 6:00-8:00 p.m. kids (and adults) do a little crafting to celebrate creativity. It's fun, messy, and very busy.

Shift Times: 5:45-8:00 p.m.

Volunteer Floater

When there are 5 different venues, someone is going to need help. This floater position is on the move. This position travels to the different venues and fills in where volunteers are needed (in a pinch). This is perfect for a "date night" roving and 2 people have more fun filling this position with the different slots.

Shift times: 5:45-7:45 p.m.
7:30-9:30 p.m.
9:15-11:15 p.m.

Volunteer Sites

Volunteers typically like to volunteer at the location that is hosting entertainers that they would like to watch while they volunteer. The final performance schedule is typically available in November and announced on the website.

Every venue is supported by site coordinators who are there to support volunteers, answer questions, and provide additional information. Volunteers will be provided with detailed information about the site and the event upon confirmation of volunteer signup.
