Help us make New Year's Fest a night to remember! New Year's Fest runs from 6:00pm to midnight with live music, heated tents, food trucks, indoor venues, fireworks & more. Volunteers can pick up their buttons starting at 5:30 p.m. and then see shows before or after their shifts. And, depending on the locations, volunteers can also see the shows while volunteering. It's really flexible, fun, and rewarding.

Volunteer Positions

Button Checkers:

These volunteers will greet guests as they enter the buildings and check to make sure that each guest is wearing a NYF button. If you sign up early enough, this is a great spot for a group of volunteers. In some locations, you can even see the shows!

Information Tent:

This volunteer position helps to manage the Bronson Park information tent. This includes the distribution of event information, and general needs in the park. This position is in a heated tent at Bronson Park.
